Download the Teamsnap Tournament app (this is different that the standard Teamsnap app) to get schedule information, alerts and real-time scores with TeamSnap Tournaments.

To download the Teamsnap Tournament app, go to the Google Play Store or Apple App Store to find app:

3. In app sign in using your email address and follow our tournament, The Kraken Kup.

4. Now you can see favorite your team, see division schedules, and can receive real-time scores, updates, and notifications.

# **COVID** Rules

Safety of our players, coaches, spectators and volunteers is of upmost importance this weekend.

Fundy Female follows all guidelines put forth by Hockey NB and Public Health (HNB.ca)

<u>Proof of vaccination is required along with a government issued ID.</u> This will be checked <u>each time</u> you enter the rink so please be prepared to show the attendants. Spectators are required to wear masks at all times. Please maintain social distancing when possible and review any signage at each rink as it may vary from rink to rink.

Players must wear masks at all times except when they put on their helmet and head out to the rink to play. Coaches, masks required at all times.

\*Sussex Rink, 8<sup>th</sup> Hussars Sports Centre- in addition to the above, NO drinks permitted.

\*Hampton Rink rules vary- in addition to the above, NO food or drink permitted in the arena. Entry allowed 30 mins prior to game and spectators asked to watch from the stands only.

RNS – No food or drink is permitted in the arena. You can enter the arena 30 minutes before the game.

### Other things worth noting

KRAKEN KUP hoodies will be sold for \$45 (tax included, cash only) at the TWO MAIN arenas (Rothesay Arena and Stewart Hurley). Various sizes available.
